For new members, we are a non-handicapped Saturday morning 9-hole league of approximately 100 women.

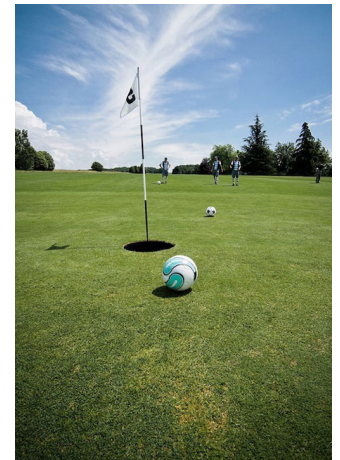

## 2021 Registration and Dues

### REGISTRATION

### DUES: NEW MEMBERS

The annual league fee for new members is \$120.

Green fees, a deposit for late cancellations and the cost of skills clinics are not included in this registration fee.

Each playdate you will need to arrive early and check in with the pro shop to pay for green fees (\$15-\$17, plus \$10 per rider for carts).

### DUES: RETURNING MEMBERS

Take advantage of early registration fees of \$80, the discount is available through March 1; fee is \$110 if received after March 1.

### INCLUDED IN DUES

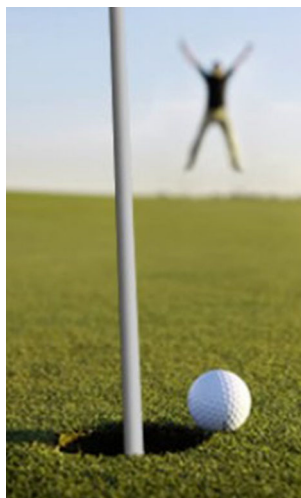
Prize money for each playdate, food for the Happy Hour, party on the first day of championship, year-end luncheon and money for annual prize pools (discussed below). Parties subject to Covid-19 restrictions.

### SKILLS CLINICS

Foothills golf course typically offers skills clinics with one of their golf pro's exclusively for our members. Availability of these clinics is entirely depending on Covid-19 restrictions at the time. We will provide information at a later date once we have more information.

## Prize Pools

We will have two season-long prize pools this year and the cost of these pools is included in your annual registration fees:



### RINGERS

The Ringers pool is where we keep track of your best score on each individual hole throughout the season. At the end of the season, the best score for each hole is added together for a 9-hole score. The result is your best score if you had pulled together your best performance in a single round.

Take a minute to imagine if you pulled your best game together all at the same time!!!

Prizes are awarded to the top three winners for each flight at the year-end celebration.

### HOLE-IN-ONE

Hole-in-One is Back!!!

There is a prize awarded to any member who achieves a Hole-in-One during any league play date during the season. The optional fun play day at the year-end luncheon is excluded from this pool.

If there is more than one winner over the course of a season the prize money is split between all winners that year.

Prizes are awarded at the year-end celebration.



## 2021 Calendar of Events

### SEASON KICKOFF

Due to ongoing Covid-19 restrictions this breakfast has been cancelled. We recognize how much our members missed the social interactions of a normal season due to Covid-19. Like 2020, we will remain very flexible this year and if we are able to safely host large group celebrations we will. Thanks for your ongoing patience.

## League Policies and Additional Information



### EACH PLAYDATE

- It is your responsibility to know your tee time and arrive in a timely manner.
- Check in with the clubhouse at least **30 minutes** prior to your tee time. Please check in prior to visiting the restaurant, bar or practice facilities.
- Please be at the first tee box **10 minutes** prior to your scheduled tee time. Your playing partners will not wait for you.
- Some playdates require players to play with other members in their flight so PLEASE stick with your assigned tee time.
- Please do not switch around your tee time on the day of play, it wreaks havoc on the starter, the Tournaments team and your fellow members.
- Game-of-the-Day will be included in the emails for that play date and posted on the clubhouse doors.

- It is your responsibility to have an understanding of golf etiquette and the general rules of golf!

### COURSE DELAYS AND CANCELLATIONS

- If you are concerned about a delayed or canceled play date due to weather please start by calling the pro shop 303-409-2400, they will have announcements if the course is closed for the day.
- For league specific cancellations please keep an eye out for an email from the Board or contact one of the Board Members if necessary. You should assume we are playing on time unless you hear differently.
- Please note that sometimes there are course delays that can quickly right themselves. Unless there is a cancellation of the play date you should be at the course in time for your normally scheduled tee time and if nothing else, use the extra time to get in a

little shopping, eating or practice.

### MEMBER CANCELLATION POLICY

- Cancellations must be submitted prior to midnight on the Saturday PRIOR to our play date or a \$15 fee is imposed.
- Cancellations after that time are "late cancellations" and should be communicated to the pro shop at 303-409-2400 along with an email to our schedulers.
- Any late cancellations or no-shows will result in the assessment of a \$15 late cancellation fee. Payment should be made to WWGL Foothills in care of our Treasurer, Diane Max-Dechant.
- Missed tee times may result in disqualification from winning any prizes on that date.
- "Insurance" is no longer included in your registration fees so there will no longer be refunds of unused funds at the end of the season.
